Call for Short papers: deadline Monday 8 May Monday 22 May 2023

Short papers that report on work in progress will be reviewed by at least three members of the international program committee. Accepted papers in this track will be selected for oral presentation and published in the LIPIcs conference proceedings. Short papers must be written in English and should not exceed six pages (including title, figures, and references) and in the requested LIPIcs layout. In addition, each submission must have a subtitle 'Short Paper' to distinguish Full papers from Short papers. Details are at the <u>GIScience CFP</u>. Papers should be submitted through <u>Easychair</u>.
